The chair officers read their duties. The Faithful Navigator then led the assembly in the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance. The previous meeting minutes were skipped due to the officer induction ceremony activity and the St. Andrew Silver Rose procession.

Faithful Navigator Report:

Is proud of the Assembly because of the many activities.

- 1. Officer installation for the newly elected was held at St. Andrews. The event included the blessing of the swords and an evening dinner with wives and friends of the Assembly.
- 2. New Chaplin Fr. Mike Kingery pastor of St. Andrew. Note his availability may be limited at our Thursday Assembly meetings as this is his normal day off.
- 3. Honor guard was held for the wedding ceremony of Tim and Jackie Krulia.
- 4. In July the assembly meeting was replaced with the Silver Rose Handoff. Three silver roses were passed from council to council. Kudos to Dennis Klein for helping set up the event.
- 5. Assembly honor guard was held for Mike Kl1mshuk. Forty three knights attended filling the three isles of All Saints Church during the ceremony.
- 6. Msgr. Donovan funeral. The Assembly assisted in the honor guard at All Saints Church watching over the casket and assisting in other parts of the funeral. This included 24 hour all-night vigil. Successfully set up by Bob Mitchell even though the request was impromptu.



Other items:

- 1. St. Brigid has a scheduling issue with providing the assembly with a hall to use for our Thursday meetings. Mary Our Queen also has scheduling issues on the next few Thursdays. The suggestion is to move the meeting to Mary Our Queen. The next meeting will be held the second Wednesday (September 12) at Mary Our Queen. This is a one-time exception to the normally scheduled meeting which occurs on the second Thursday. October 11, next meeting at St. Andrew. Will plan for St. Brigid in the future.
- 2. **Membership** We are behind in our membership campaign. We currently only acquired 5 additional 4th degree members at the June exemplification. We need better recruiting. Both All Saints and St. Brigid have hundreds of third degree members and can be prime opportunity for recruiting. The next exemplification event occurs on November 10th. Target 54 members over the next two exemplifications this fraternal year (Fall and next Spring). Suggest All Saints (20), St. Brigid (20), St. Andrew (10), Mary Our Queen (4).

Discussion – budget:

Stan – budget covers regalia.

Discussion about covering cost of meal.

Stan Wasowski – Welcome Home Veterans project at St. Peter Channel. Participation from several councils – all day affair. The event started with a welcome breakfast followed by presentations honoring returning veterans. This turned out to be a big event attended by over 100 veterans and veteran support groups.

Social committee events: 3 events planned.

Faithful Navigator: budget ~\$4,000 this year for dinners. Increased.

- 2. Dinner with wives. Carbonara the owner is willing to offer to dedicate one Monday evening to accommodate the Assembly's next dinner.

Chalice report - Ernie Spencer.

Chalice fund provides a chalice to deacons preparing for the priesthood. Engraved with names of deceased brothers. It's difficult to give away as family members already provide one for the prospective deacon / priest. Proposed that we offer as a second chalice for use "on the road". Also, it's difficult to contact people. We obtain the names from the Archdiocese Vocations Office, but they never return calls. This year we will try to give to an ordained deacon. That way the chalice can be consecrated when he becomes a priest.
