St. Brigid (Kobylski) –

- On December 11th, 42 council brothers cooked and served 345 breakfast plates at our Annual Breakfast w/Santa.
- On Sunday December 12th, the Council conducted our 3rd Annual Chili Challenge and donations received were donated to St. Vincent de Paul to care for a family that did not get their paperwork in for the annual KofC “Adopt-A-Family” Holiday Program.
