#### Faithful Comptroller Report (Dave Mason)

1. Confirming checking account balance as of 3-12-2016 \$9,707.52
2. Membership: With the addition of 8 New Sir Knights in February the NEW total is 203 Members. We have paperwork completed for a transfer in and paperwork being processed for a restoration.
3. Next Exemplification: April 23 in Macon, GA. Need completed form # 4 and Check for \$80. This \$80.00 covers Exemplification fee and \$10 for 4th Degree Badge. Deadline is April 1. Make check payable to K of C Assembly # 2688.
4. Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity: Last year the Knights of Columbus contributed \$173 million to charitable causes. Also K of C per-formed over 71 million hours to volunteer services. I do not have the final National numbers yet. But it appears both are up 8 percent.  
 Assembly # 2688: Participation: 61%. Last year 43 %. Overall hours are up 21% over last year (3827 vs 3153 hours). Great job!
5. Membership Dues: I have received payment from approximately 90 % of the members. We have 26 members who still owe the \$30.00 annual fee  
 I have heard from five who say they will pay this week. And a couple of the SKs have some health issues which we will review. Another issue this year is the new SKs think that if they pay Council dues they do not need to pay Assembly dues. Assembly and Councils have separate dues and have separate membership cards. If you are outstanding in your dues, please pay in March. If you have paid recently, I have your membership card.
