Future Chalice Report — (Chalice #23 Filled), Chalice #24 Filled)

Ed Pierson had already been engaged with finding recipients for Chalices #20 and #21 which are fully reserved with beloved deceased names. We had slated a member of the All Saints RSVP program, Paul Nacey, who just became a priest, but he no longer needs a chalice.

Monsignor Marren put us in touch with a nurse, Ide Maya of Catholic World Missions, who knows of chalice needs in the Congo. We have sent two chalices off to her in that country. Chalice recipient names will follow for #20 and #21 as they are presented.

Chalices #22 and #23 and #24 are still not spoken for, although decedent names are assigned.

Decedent names were later rearranged to ensure that Wiley Maloof, son Marion Maloof, and dear friend of theirs, Deacon Ed Krise, were all listed on the same chalice #22 together.

In August 2021, the passing of Joseph Kane, and then Marion Maloof in early September, necessitated the planning for chalice #24. The chalice names fill with Deacon Ray Egan's passing.

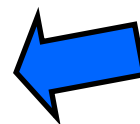

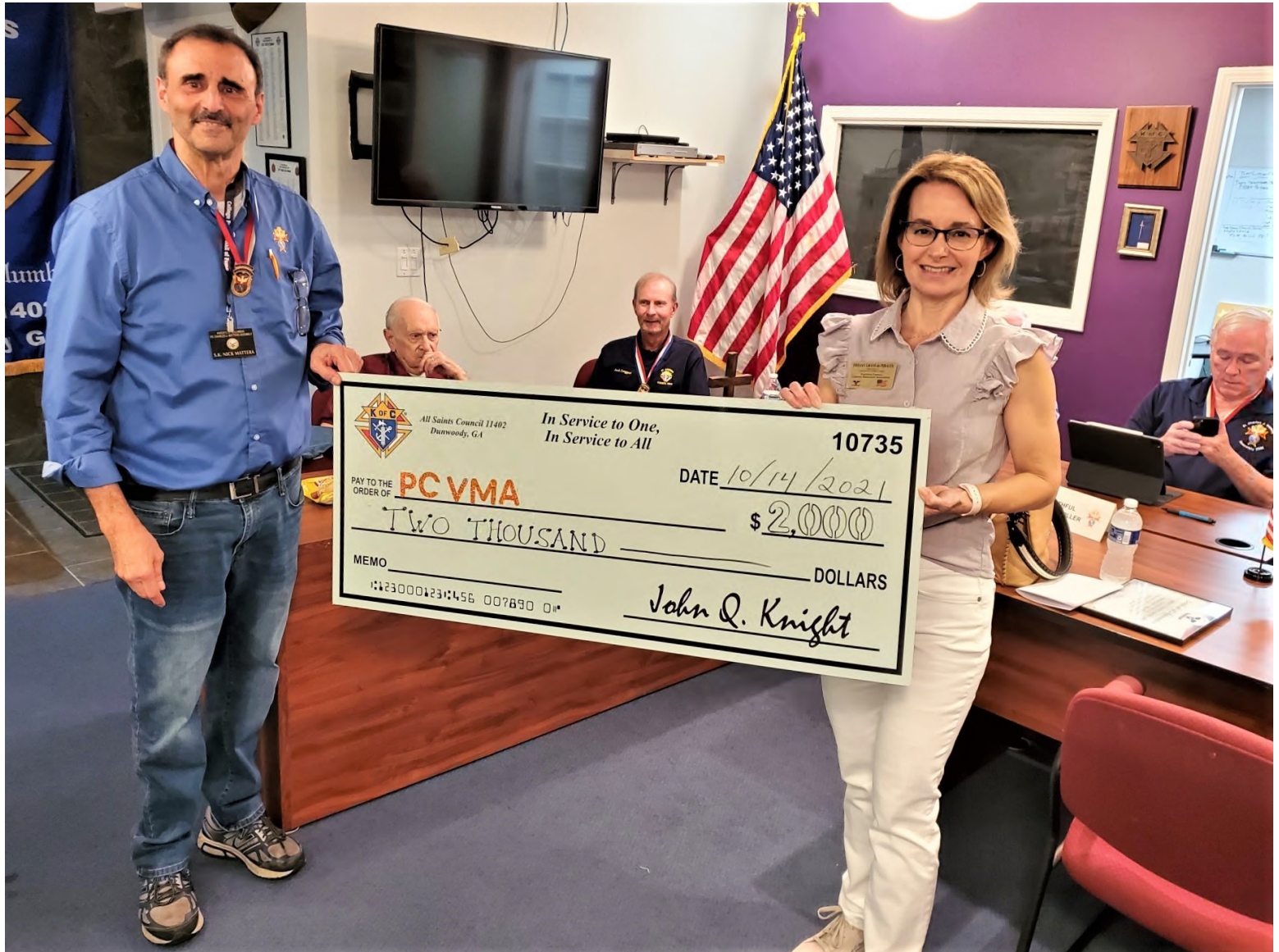

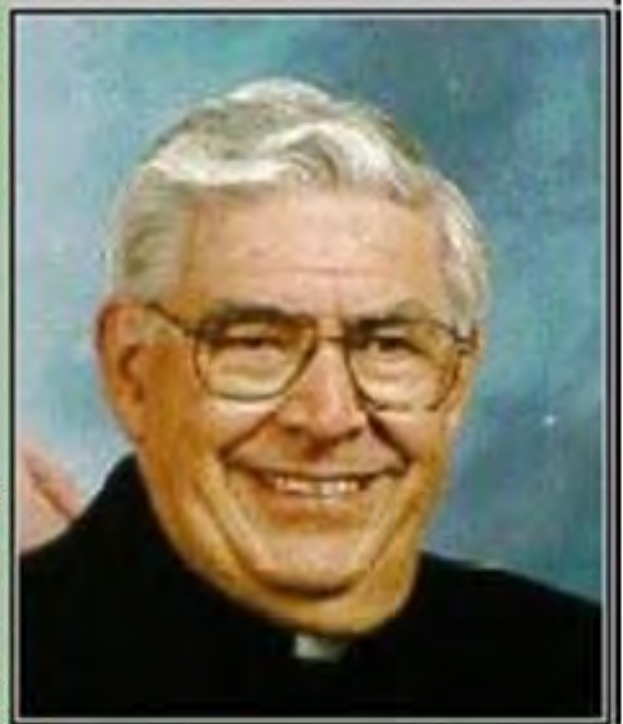
Deacon Raymond Egan Has Passed
